The Intelligent Irish Investigators, or Triple I, work on a variety of projects that encompass the areas of science, the arts, physical activity and social studies. Triple I will also

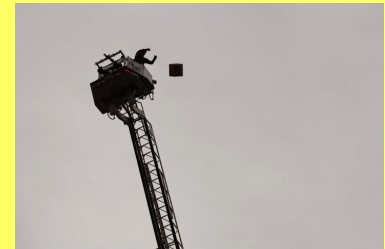


include a Crime Fighter and Forensics segment that will engage students by showing them how the structure of atoms, interactions of energy and matter, and chemical reactions all help solve crimes.

# ART CLUB

St. Joseph's Art Club offers additional studio time and instruction for students eager to create more challenging works of Art.

Examples of Art to be covered include but not limited to:

Art Club consists of five 2-hour sessions (3:00pm to 5:00pm). It is split into 3 groups:

1st Session:

2nd through 5th Grade (starts September 9th)

2nd Session:

Kindergarten and 1st Grade

3rd Session:

6th through 8th Grade.

The cost is \$45 per session and each session is limited to a maximum of 15 students.
